

Dress Code Regulations

The Board has attempted to be proactive in monitoring and enforcing the Dress Code of the Victoria Golf Club. Although some areas of our Dress Code have become more socially updated, our expectation is that Members present themselves with the respect due their fellow members. It is also the responsibility of the Members to ensure the dress of their Guest(s) conforms to the Dress Code. This Dress Code is also applicable to all visitors who will be informed through the Pro Shop staff or senior Clubhouse staff.

This includes:

- **Men's shirts** must be tucked in unless they are buttoned from collar to hem and are evenly cut around the bottom.
- Exterior **cargo pockets for shorts or pants** are not permitted. Any additional pockets must be stitched flat and not able to expand. **All shorts** must be a reasonable length (four inches from the knee for men and six inches for ladies). Tennis or athletic shorts are not permitted.
- **Jeans** are allowed in the Clubhouse with the exception of dining room or functions which include the dining room (i.e. buffet dinners). All pants or shorts must be clean and must not be frayed.
- **Socks** must be knee length, white athletic or ankle. Dark colored dress socks are not permitted with shorts.
- **Men's Capri** style pants are not permitted.
- When using the **dining room**, business casual is expected.
- **Ladies' shirts** are required to have collars or sleeves on the golf course with no midriff showing.
- **Golf shoes** are allowed throughout the facility. Running shoes and strapped sandals are allowed in Macan's. Rubber flip-flops are not permitted.
- Men are not permitted to wear **hoodies or athletic workout materials**.



Cargo pockets for pants or shorts are not permitted.



Men's golf shirts must be tucked in, unless it is a full button down shirt.

Dress Code – Golf Course

(Jeans are not permitted on course or practice facilities.)

Men

- Pants and shorts are to be tailored; cargo pockets are not permitted, nor is denim of any type or color.
- Shorts must be longer than four inches above the knee, but no more than one inch below the knee. Any additional pockets must be stitched flat and not be able to expand.
- Dress socks are not to be worn with shorts.
- Golf shirts must be tucked in, unless designed to be worn outside shorts or trousers (defined as buttoned from collar to hem, hemmed and evenly cut around the bottom).
- Hoodies, tee shirts, sweat and athletic pants/shorts are not permitted.

Ladies

- Shorts, dresses and skirts cannot be shorter than six inches from the knee. Cargo pockets are not permitted, nor is denim of any type or color. Any additional pockets must be stitched flat and not able to expand.
- Halter tops, tank tops and sweat pants are not permitted. Golf shirts are required to have a collar or sleeves.

General

- Logos on hats and clothing must be discreet and should be golf-related. Only soft-spiked golf shoes are permitted on the course or in the Clubhouse.



Men are not permitted to wear hoodies or athletic material (sweatshirts).



Hats are acceptable on the golf course, permitting the logo is discreet or golf related.



Dark colored dress socks are not permitted with shorts.

Dress Code – Clubhouse

Dining Room – Unless otherwise authorized by the Board, business casual is expected.

Macan's – Golf attire is acceptable. Additionally, dress can be sports casual or semi-formal. Shorts and socks have the same requirements as on the golf course. Men's shirts are to be tucked in at the waist unless designed to be worn untucked (defined as buttoned from collar to hem, hemmed and evenly cut around the bottom). Any logos must be discreet and should be golf-related.

Hats/Caps - With the exception of formal men's and ladies' hats, no headwear is permitted on the upper floor of the Clubhouse.

Shoes – Golf Shoes may be worn anywhere in the Clubhouse (soft-spikes only). Rubber flip-flops are not acceptable footwear.

Jeans – Acceptable in the Clubhouse with exception to the dining room and dining room functions (i.e. buffets or specialty brunches which include the dining room). They can not be frayed or ripped.

The dress code will be enforced by the General Manager, Food and Beverage Manager and the Duty Manager on the upper floor; and by the Pro Shop staff on the lower floor or golf course.



Rubber flip-flops and cargo shorts are not permitted in the Clubhouse or on the golf course.
