



Victoria Golf Club Policy on the Holding of Outside Championships

Purpose: To identify the requirements for hosting a recognized Zone, Provincial, Regional or National Golf Association must meet to hold a Championship at Victoria Golf Club (VGC).

Summary: As one of the premier golf clubs in Canada, it is in the interests of VGC to host on a regular basis (every 5-10 years), marquee golf Championships on a local, Provincial, Regional or National scale. We see great value in supporting events hosted by BC Golf, Golf Canada, the PGA of Canada, PNGA, USGA, Zone 5 & PGA of BC.

Details:

1. Either VGC or a local, Provincial, Regional or National Association may request to hold a Championship at VGC.
2. To have an enhanced chance of approval such requests should meet many of the following criteria:
 - a. Early application – preferably 2 years prior to the proposed Championship;
 - b. Minimal disruption to Member play;
 - c. Green fee revenue to VGC;
 - d. Food and beverage revenue to VGC;
 - e. Volunteer opportunities for VGC Members;
 - f. Branding, cresting, and other merchandise sales opportunities for VGC.
3. Such requests, if from an Association, will be routed through VGC's General Manager or Head Golf Professional and must have the approval of VGC's Board of Directors.

Approval – This policy was approved by the VGC Board of Directors on March 12, 2024, and became effective on April 1, 2024.
