



Dress Code Principles

As a Victoria Golf Club member, it is your responsibility to be familiar with and adhere to the dress code. Golf attire should be clean, well-maintained, and properly fitted, aligning with the Club's standards, current professional trends, and traditions of the game of golf.

Members are responsible for ensuring their guests comply with the dress code. The dress code does not apply to the parking lot or locker rooms. Questions or concerns regarding the dress code should be directed to the Pro Shop or Clubhouse staff. In accordance with the Member Code of Conduct, members should never approach another member or guest directly regarding possible dress code violations.

On-Course & Practice Areas: All Genders Aged 9+

- Golf pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts are all permitted.
- Golf-appropriate footwear is required and must be worn at all times on course and in practice areas.
- Golf-related logos of any size are acceptable. Non-golf-related logos should be small and discreet. Logos containing foul language or political/religious statements are not permitted.
- Hats must be worn with the brim facing forward. Exceptionally, they may be worn backward due to inclement weather.
- Golf-style hoodies are permitted.
- After 5 PM daily and during Clubhouse special events, Clubhouse attire is permitted on the putting/chipping green next to the Clubhouse.

On-Course & Practice Areas: Men and Boys Aged 9+

- Golf shirts must have sleeves and a collar (Polo-style, turtleneck, mock-neck, blade collar, or quarter-zip) and must be tucked in at all times while on the course.

On-Course & Practice Areas: Women and Girls Aged 9+

- Golf shirts with sleeves are not required to have a collar, while sleeveless shirts must include a collar (Polo-style, turtleneck, mock-neck, blade collar, or quarter-zip).
- Golf shirts may be worn untucked if they are specifically designed for that style.
- Golf dresses are permitted with or without a collar.
- Solid-coloured, golf-appropriate leggings may be worn without a skirt or shorts.



On-Course & Practice Areas: Juniors Under Age 9

- Juniors and children under 9 may wear non-golf-specific clothing and footwear, provided attire is appropriate for golf.
- Golf-related logos of any size are acceptable. Non-golf-related logos should be small and discreet. Logos containing foul language or political/religious statements are not permitted.
- While playing on the golf course, children are encouraged to make an effort to conform to the “Adults and Children Aged 9+” dress code.

Upstairs Clubhouse & Men’s 19th: Adults and Children Aged 9+

- Acceptable attire includes golf, smart casual, denim jeans, semi-formal, and formal wear.
- Footwear must be worn at all times; any style is acceptable, with the exception of rubber flip-flops, slides, and similar rubber sandals.
- Headwear must be removed in these areas, except for formal hats.
- Special events may have alternate dress codes, which will be communicated in advance.
- For men, T-shirts are not permitted to be worn on their own in the Clubhouse.

Upstairs Clubhouse: Children Under Age 9

- Children under 9 are not subject to the dress code. The supervising adult is responsible for ensuring children’s attire is clean and well-maintained.
- Children under 9 must remove headwear upon entering the upstairs Clubhouse.
